William James Vineyard, the newest property in the Price Family portfolio, is named after Bill's son. And just like James himself, it is full of youthful potential. The site resides in the Green Valley region of the Russian River Valley and sits between the towns of Sebastopol and Freestone. Decades ago, Gravenstein apples were grown in the deep and fluffy Goldridge soils of this site. In 2013, we planted an assortment of Heritage and Dijon clones – grapes that thrive in this foggy climate. The wine has aromas of nutmeg and tart, red plum compote, with an explosion of baked blackberries on the palate. There is an exuberance to this wine that brings brightness and promises longevity.
